Role of the Audiologist:

- Use of technology to identify, test, diagnose, and manage disorders of human hearing, balance, and interpret test results of behavioural and objective measures
- Counsel patients about hearing health and the possible need for treatment/management
- Assess the candidacy of persons with hearing loss for hearing aids and cochlear implants and provide fitting, programming, and audio logic rehabilitation to ensure the best possible outcomes
- Evaluate and manage children and adults with central auditory processing disorders
- Screen speech-language, the use of sign language, and other factors affecting communication function for the purposes of audio logic evaluation and/or initial identification of individuals with other communication disorders
- Help people with these disorders better communicate and connect with the world around them.
- Working in close collaboration with Speech Therapist.
