Role of the Occupational Therapist at the Centre:

- To organise the meaningful activities- playing and learning for the overall development to make them independent.
- Working on muscle and joint coordination issues — issues that can make everyday tasks difficult. Some of these tasks include eating, brushing teeth and bathing.
- Help the children to improve physical, cognitive and social abilities, as well as fine motor skills and posture.
- Working on difficulties with processing sensory information/ Sensory stimulation and integration.
- Working in close collaboration with Special Educators and other professional.
